Open House and Spirit Wear

- Open House is Wednesday, August 25th from 6-7pm and the PTO table will be in the lobby.
 - The PTO will be selling NH Hawk signs at \$10/each. Ms. Olson is presenting the sale of the hawk signs to the board and will let the PTO know of any issues. Emilee will bring the signs to Open House.

Hawk Flocking

- Hawk flocking will run from September 1st – September 15th.
 - The PTO will start 2 large flocks (approx. 20 hawks) in Onalaska. The house will receive a notice they've been "flocked" and will be asked to migrate the flock to a new house within 48 hours. The notice will include the PTO Venmo QR code and PayPal information to allow for donation, and a #hashtag for sharing a photo op.
 - If the receiving family would like to "adopt" a hawk from the flock, they will be asked to donate \$10 to the PTO per sign they would like to keep (via PayPal, Venmo, or cash/check to the school).
 - Considerations: Hawk signs should have flocking instructions on the back, so the receiving family knows how to move it forward, or multiple copies of the notice should be passed along from house to house. The notice should have instructions to contact the PTO if more signs are needed, or if they prefer to have the signs picked up from their home. The notice will ask the final families to return the remaining (not-adopted) hawks back to their nest (Northern Hills) on September 15th or contact NH PTO for pick-up.
